Contemporary Health Tourism coincides with the Internet Century - in other words, today and tomorrow.

And what should we expect to see?

Chairperson: Telemedicine - Dr. Nayak Speakers:

Theme: Telemedicine is the use of telecommunication and information technology to provide clinical health care from a distance. It has been used to overcome distance barriers and to improve access to medical services that would often not be consistently available in distant rural communities. It is also used to save lives in critical care and emergency situations.

Although there were distant precursors to telemedicine, it is essentially a product of 20th century telecommunication and information technologies. These technologies permit communications between patient and medical staff with both convenience and fidelity, as well as the transmission of medical, imaging and health informatics, data from one site to another. For example, it is possible to perform dialysis using remote monitoring using telemedicine and mHealth platforms.

Ayush comprises of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy systems.

Ayurveda: The word Ayurveda derived from AYU and VEDA. AYU means life VEDA means science or knowledge. Ayurveda means the science of life.

**Yoga:** Yoga is an Art and Science of healthy living. It is a spiritual discipline based on an extremely subtle science, which focuses on bringing harmony between mind and body

**Unani:** Unani-tibb or Unani Medicine is a form of traditional medicine practiced Asian countries. It refers to a tradition of Graeco-Arabic medicine, which is based on the teachings of Greek physician Hippocrates and Roman physician Galen.

**Siddha:** The Siddha system of medicine is mainly practised in the Southern part of India. The word Siddha has its origin in the Tamil word Siddhi which means "an object to be attained" or "perfection" or "heavenly bliss".
